Her past roles include Mimi (*La Bohéme*), Fiordiligi (*Cosi Fan Tutte: A Remix*), Tiresias (*Les Mamelles de Tirésias*), Pamina (*Die Zauberflöte*), and scenes as Gilda (*Rigoletto*), Adina (*L'elisir d'amore*), Norina (*Don Pasquale*), Lucia (*Lucia di Lammermoor*), Juliette (*Romeo et Juliette*) and Baroness (*Der Wildschütz*).

Laura is happy to be back at The Florentine Opera as a Baumgartner Studio Artist for the 2023-2024 season. She will be singing Gianetta, Guadalena, and covering Musetta.



Tzytle Steinman

Tzytle Steinman (Mezzo-Soprano) is originally from San Diego, CA. This is her second year as a

Baumgartner Studio Artist. She has performed with multiple companies including Ohio Light Opera, Fargo-Moorhead Opera, San Diego Opera, and Utah Festival Opera. This summer she will be a Young Artist with the Glimmerglass Festival. Her roles include Buttercup in HMS Pinafore, Venus in Orpheus in the Underworld, Rosina in the Barber of Seville (Tour), Dinah in Trouble in Tahiti, Tisbe in La Cenerentola and Prince Orlofsky in Die Fledermaus. Tzytle is a recipient of three Encouragement Awards from the Metropolitan Opera Competition and is a Prize winner of the Patricia Crump Vocal Grand Competition. She was also a contestant on the Price is Right.



Jerek Fernández

Jerek Fernández is a tenor hailing from San Juan, Puerto Rico. Fernández is currently a

Baumgartner Studio Artist at The Florentine Opera. For this upcoming summer, Jerek looks forward to being part of Wolf Trap Opera's Studio Artist Program.
